Niangua River Oasis Inc.

Campground offers a variety of aquatic activities, including boat rentals. Good privacy for troops and co-ed leaders. Camping is free if canoes are rented; owners are willing to reduce the price of camping if service is performed. Water is available on the site; shelters also present. Showerhouses on site.

Gasconade Hills

Canoe and float trips on the Gasconade River; several floats return to the campground itself, for a good day activity. Water, flush toilets, showerhouses on site. No designated scout area, but troops welcome. Fishing on site; all facilities suited for scouting activities.

Canoe and tube float trips. Lots of property with unmarked trails for hiking. Some maps available. Fishing on site; toilets, water, and shower houses. Can create your own high adventure activities and use this as a base camp. Welcomes scouts.

Area offers cabins, shower houses, and other amenities, including indoor basketball court and kitchen area. Cost for scouts is reasonable. Tent camping also possible. Out-of-the-way location on the Mississippi River. Used often in the summer for a variety of church and YMCA camps; dormant in winter. On Hwy 79, south of Hannibal, turn left to go to Saverton. At "T" junction, turn left again. Follow road until it becomes gravel. Follow gravel road up the hill, runs right into camp.
