4. Banquet

- a. Food – We will be cooking the food ourselves as opposed to having a restaurant or food service company catering for us; adults will specifically be asked for assistance in extensive preparations (frying chicken, for example). P. Mahoney made a motion for this proposal, and the motion was seconded; it passed with no objections. As of now, the menu will consist of the following items: Fried chicken, tossed salad, rolls, green beans and corn, roasted potato, fruit salad, chocolate sheet cake, possibly a second meat (if there is going to be a second meat for certain, this will be decided in December); drinks will consist of water, fruit punch, and tea. The menu will be finalized in December.
 - b. Chapter assignments – Check-in will be managed by Taleka; Gawi will manage registration; kitchen assistance will be managed by Wiechcheu; and, lastly, clean up will be managed by Amoe.
 - c. Training cells – Elangomat training under the direction of John Murphy, Nimat training under the direction of John Murphy, Native American drumming (possibly under the direction of B. Cearly), Native American dancing under the direction of P. Mahoney, and LLD training under the direction of J. Bingaman and _____.

Additionally, Section C5C wants each lodge to do a One Day of Service project: Brad Corwin wants each chapter to brainstorm ideas.
