### Moves to change

In the Lodge handbook posited May 2007 Revision Purpose these changes

**Move that** on page 4 A Brief History of the Nampa-Tsi Lodge  
The forth paragraph be removed.

**Reason** the vote made at the May 07 L.E.C. Put to rest any further adherence to custom and traditions. The Four Fires was the pre ordeal for the Metab Lodge not used for many years.

**Move that** on page 5 Important Events in the Order of the Arrow History  
The words “Metab society established” be replaced with “\* Metab Lodge #216 of the Lake of the Ozarks Council is established”

**Reason** Metab was a real Lodge.  
Lake of the Ozarks Council was a real council.

**Move that** on pages 6&7 the legend of the Great Nampa-Tsi Lodge  
Be removed. And an ad hoc committee is formed to investigate the lodge history to write a legend for our lodge based in facts.

**Reason** not very well written and paid little mind to the facts.

**Move that** on page 13 The Lodge Operating Committees of the Lodge Executive Committees  
The ordeal, Brotherhood, and Vigil Honor committees are made sub committees of the Ceremony committee.

**Reason** sense the Ceremony Masters and Vigil chief head this committee anyway this will reduce the number needed to make quorum. Witch has been a problem

**Move That** the Ceremony, Camping Promotion, Service/Activities, Elections/ Membership and Communications committees be preceded with an \*. The note at bottom of page to read “standing committees”

- Reason** Ad Hoc committees are only part time at best and will reduce the number needed to make quorum.
- Move that** on page 12/ 6<sup>th</sup>. Par graft is changed to read “The ratification of any issue presented before the Lodge Executive Committee requires a simple majority of all voting members present unless a two-thirds majority is called for by Roberts Rules of Order.
- Move that** on page 12 between par graft 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> be added “the ratification of any change to The Operating Rules, Procedures, and Bylaws of The Nampa-Tsi Lodge proposed with a 2/3 vote of the L.E.C. And have been posted on the Nampa-Tsi website for not less than 3 weeks prior to the next scheduled L.E.C. A vote up or down will be taken from all Lodge members in good standing and under 21 years of age a 2/3 majority will be needed to make any change.
- Reason** with a set of rules that can be changed each time the L.E.C. meets how they can be concerted binding.
- On page 15?
- Move that** on page 21 Recognition Bead for dance team Youth and adult be named
- Reason** because Carl wanted one
- Question** on page 25 in Section III of Article IV: Call-Out who will send this letter???
- Move that** on page 29 Clause I: of section V: in Article VIII be amended to read  
 Clause I the Ballot Counting and Election Procedures  
 a. The Advancement Vice Chief shall determine the number voting members present at the election.  
 b. Each chapter may submit 1 youth and 1 adult for the counting of the ballots after the lodge adviser has collected them.  
 c. After the ballots have been tallied, they must be destroyed the final statistical results being withheld.
- Move that** on page 30 & 31 Clauses I-X section III in article X be amended to read  
 The ordeal, Brotherhood, and Vigil Honor committees are made sub committees of the Ceremony committee.
- Reason** sense the Ceremony Masters and Vigil chief head this committee anyway this will reduce the number needed to make quorum. Witch has been a problem
- Move That** the Ceremony, Camping Promotion, Service/Activities, Elections/ Membership and Communications committees be preceded with an \*. The note at bottom of page to read “standing committees”
- Reason** Ad Hoc committees are only part time at best and will reduce the number needed to make quorum.

**Move that** on page 30 section III be added “no person who is already a voting member of the L.E.C. May chair any standing committee”

**Move that** on page 32 Article X a new section be added  
Section IX : Quorum  
Clause I: Any Standing Committee that does not have a chair does not count toward or against quorum  
Clause II: A Chapter must be active to be counted toward quorum  
II a: to be active a chapter must have a voting member present 2 of the last 4 L.E.C. Meeting.  
Clause III: Lodge chief does not count toward quorum.

**Move that** on page 34 Section I Article XIV be amended to read “ Any change to The Operating Rules, Procedures, and Bylaws of The Nampa-Tsi Lodge proposed with a 2/3 vote of the L.E.C. And have been posted on the Nampa-Tsi website for not less than 3 weeks prior to the next scheduled L.E.C. A vote up or down will be taken from all Lodge members in good standing and under 21 years of age a 2/3 majority will be needed to make any change.”

**Reason** with a set of rules that can be changed each time the L.E.C. meets how they can be concerted binding.

**Move that** on page 34 Section IV of Article XVII be removed tell rewritten.
